Program-specific regulations

(1) Specific admission requirements

- Dual study program: The students apply directly at one of the praxis partners. As part of the selection process applicants take part in a test, which includes tasks in the areas of mathematical understanding and logic.
- English level B2 or similar (IELTS/TOEFL), German level C1 or similar

(2) General provisions of the degree program

- The dual degree includes 210 CP within 3,5 years. 1 CP equals 25 hours of workload. The weighting of the modules for the calculation of the final grade for the bachelor's degree is correspondent to the CP.
- All exams within a module need to be passed in order to clear one module.
- Type of study: On campus study combined with practical phases (at the practical partner)

(3) Particular rules regarding the contents of the program

- Module Electives (8 CP): Student select two elective courses. All elective courses will be announced during the 6th semester.
- In communication with the practical partner, students select their dedicated specialization (municipal or entrepreneurial specialization).
- The study program includes three practical phases (Module 6/7: 12 CP, 10 weeks, Module 13/14: 12 CP, 10 weeks, Module 20/21/22, 22 CP, 15 weeks).
- Further regulations for the dual degree program are documented in the study agreement and the cooperation agreement.
- Modules 1-5: main teaching language is German; all other modules: main teaching language is English. Technical English is taught along the course of the modules 1-5.

(4) Thesis and specific provisions for graduation

- a. At the beginning of the Bachelor thesis, all examinations, except for 8 CP, must be passed. The 5 ECTS of module 29 (leadership&communication) is not included in this requirements for the start of the bachelor thesis. This module is accomplished parallel to the bachelor thesis.
- b. Thesis work is scheduled for 16 weeks during the final semester.

The Colloquium is set for 60 minutes and consists of a presentation part and an oral part. The examination will take place only after passing all other examinations
