VISA (if applicable): since the visa application process can take up to ten weeks, we recommend you to contact the nearest German embassy or consulate as soon as possible to make an appointment. **It is possible to arrange your appointment before you have gathered all required documents.** The following items are needed for the visa application and **have to be ready at the time of the appointment:**

- Valid passport (Please contact your embassy for details)
- Visa application form (available at the embassy or consulate)
- Sufficient knowledge for TOEFL/IELTS test (Test of English as a Foreign Language)
- Basic knowledge about Germany
- Admission letter for the study
